The Old Vines Cabernet Sauvignon (originally labeled as Dedication Series) has been in production since the bonding of the winery in 1981. Primary sourcing has always come from some of the oldest cabernet blocks and the most highly acclaimed sites in the state. The 1987 vintage was the first Washington wine to be on Wine Spectator's Top 10 list. This full-bodied cabernet can age well with proper cellar conditions, 15+ years from vintage. Produced and bottled at Woodward Canyon Winery. Store and serve at cellar temperature.
